## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a key factor influencing a student's ability to learn is the learning 2 3 environment in public schools. In addition to the high standards that Hawaii sets for students in the school system, 4 5 students need an environment where they can learn under 6 conditions that are not physically uncomfortable and free from 7 unnecessary distractions. Given Hawaii's tropical climate and 8 heat, schools should be equipped with air conditioning to ensure 9 that students have the most conducive, comfortable learning 10 environment to achieve their educational potential. 11 The purpose of this Act is to require the installation of
- The purpose of this Act is to require the installation of air conditioning in all public schools based upon the priority established by the department of education.

    (b), the department shall establish a priority list of schools

    by December 31, 2007 that are in greatest need of air
