A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN FISHPONDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 171-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§171-28 Government-owned Hawaiian [fish ponds.] fishponds; sale prohibition. (a) The board may investigate and 4 develop scientific commercial management practices for 5 government-owned Hawaiian [fish ponds] fishponds and 6 7 reconstruct, rehabilitate, improve, and stock the [fish ponds;] fishponds; and expend moneys from the special land and 8 9 development fund. All revenues derived from any governmentowned Hawaiian [fish pond] fishpond shall be deposited in the 10 11 fund.

(b) The board may lease government-owned Hawaiian [fish ponds] fishponds with legislative authorization as provided under section 171-53(c); provided that in lieu of legislative authorization, the board may lease such [fish ponds] fishponds if:
