#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

4	person shall stand in the bed or load-carrying area of any motor		
5	vehicle commonly known as a pickup truck while the vehicle is in		
6	operation. No operator of any pickup truck shall operate the		
7	vehicle with a passenger seated in the bed or load-carrying area		
8	of the vehicle [unless:		
9	(1) There is no s	eating available in the cab of the	
10	vehicle;		
11	(2) The side rack	s of the vehicle are securely attached	
12	and the tails	woard or tailgate is securely closed;	
13	(3) Every passeng	er in the bed or load-carrying area of	
14	the vehicle i	s seated on the floor and does not	
15	attempt to co	entrol unlashed cargo.	
16	(b) This section	shall not apply to persons or
