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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address the		
2	Hawaii employer-union trust fund. More specifically, this Act		
3	requires the board of trustees to contract with a carrier to		
4	provide health benefits plans to members. This Act also repeals		
5	the authority of the board of trustees to provide health		
6	benefits through self-insurance.		
7	SECTION 2. Section 87A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
8	amended by amending the definitions of "health benefits plan"		
9	and "long-term care benefits plan" to read as follows:		
10	""Health benefits plan" means[÷		
11	(1) A] <u>a</u> group insurance contract or service agreement		
12	that may include medical, hospital, surgical,		
13	prescribed drugs, vision, and dental services, in		
14	which a carrier agrees to provide, pay for, arrange		
15	for, or reimburse the cost of the services as		
16	determined by the board[; or		



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1	(2)	A similar schedule of benefits established by the
2		board and provided through the fund on a self-insured
3		basis].
4	"Long	g-term care benefits plan" means[:
5	(1)	A] \underline{a} group insurance contract or service agreement in
6		which a carrier agrees to provide, pay for, arrange
7		for, or reimburse the cost of long-term care benefits
8		as determined by the board[; or
9	(2)	A similar schedule of benefits established by the
10		board and provided through the fund on a self-insured
11		basis]."
12	SECT	ION 3. Section 87A-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
14	"(b)	The board [may] <u>shall</u> contract [for] <u>with a carrier</u>
15	to provide	e health benefits plans [or provide health benefits
16	through a	-noninsured schedule of benefits]."
17	SECTI	ION 4. Section 87A-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended by	amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
19	"(C)	The board may contract with a carrier to provide
20	fully insu	ared benefits [or with a third party administrator to
21	administer	self-insured benefits]."



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SECTION 5. Section 87-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows 3 "(b) The fund, including any earnings on investments, and 4 rate credits or reimbursements from any carrier [or self-insured 5 plan and any earning or interest derived therefrom], may be used to stabilize health and other benefit plan rates; provided that 6 the approval of the governor and the legislature shall be 7 8 necessary to fund administrative and other expenses necessary to 9 effectuate these purposes." 10 SECTION 6. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 11 12 begun before its effective date. 13 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009, and 15 shall be repealed on June 30, 2015; provided that sections 16 87A-1, 87A-16, 87A-18, and 87A-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 17 18 shall be reenacted in the form in which they read on June 30, 19 2009.
