### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HEALTH TRUST FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the				
2	provisions making the following eligible for health benefits				
3	under the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund:				
4	(1) Per diem employees of the State or a county; and				
5	(2) Contractors with the State or a county.				
6	SECTION 2. Section 87A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
7	amended by amending the definition of "employee" to read as				
8	follows:				
9	""Employee" means an employee or officer of the State,				
10	county, or legislature,				
11	(1) Including:				
12	(A) An elective officer;				
13	[ <del>(B)</del> A per diem employee;]				
14	$\left[\frac{(C)}{(C)}\right]$ (B) An officer or employee under an authorized				
15	leave of absence;
