A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECONSTITUTING SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Public schools, including charter schools,
2	which have been in restructuring for three or more years and
3	which have not advanced significantly toward improving academic
4	performance, should be reconstituted using extraordinary
5	measures. Dramatic steps must be taken to ensure that our
6	students make adequate academic progress.
7	

7 The purpose of this Act is to allow the superintendent of 8 education to:

- (1) Notwithstanding collective bargaining agreements,

 memorandums of agreement, or memorandums of

 understanding, reconstitute a public school, except a

 charter school, which has been in restructuring for

 three or more school years; and
- (2) Recommend to the charter school review panel actions that should be taken to reconstitute a charter school, which has been in restructuring for three or more school years, and recommend that the charter school review panel revoke the charter school's charter.
