A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State is
- 2 undergoing a significant and possibly protracted economic
- 3 downturn in tandem with the national and global economic and
- 4 financial crises. Numerous jobs have been lost, a number of
- 5 large and small companies have declared bankruptcy or left the
- 6 state, and many families have suffered foreclosure on their
- 7 over-mortgaged houses. In the past year, the council on
- 8 revenues has consistently reduced its forecasts of Hawaii's tax
- 9 revenues. Across-the-board spending restrictions have already
- 10 been put in place in state government and a general hiring
- 11 freeze has already been implemented except in areas that impact
- 12 public health and safety.
- 13 In the face of these extraordinary conditions, the State
- 14 cannot proceed with business as usual. All resources must be
- 15 examined to address critical statewide health, safety, and
- 16 educational needs.
- 17 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to generate
- 18 additional general funds to ensure the delivery of critical



- 1 services statewide by reallocating the distribution of moneys in
- 2 the Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund under section 328L-2,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, including depositing a certain
- 4 percentage into the state general fund.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 7 "(b) The fund shall be used for the purpose of receiving,
- 8 allocating, and appropriating the tobacco settlement moneys as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) [Twenty-four and one-half] Twenty-four and one-half
- 11 per cent shall be appropriated into the emergency and
- budget reserve fund under section 328L-3;
- (2) [Thirty-five] Twenty-five per cent shall be
- appropriated to the department for purposes of section
- 15 328L-4;
- 16 (3) [Twelve and one half] Two per cent shall be
- 17 appropriated into the Hawaii tobacco prevention and
- 18 control trust fund under section 328L-5; [and]
- 19 (4) [Twenty-eight] Twenty-three and one-half per cent
- 20 shall be appropriated into the university revenue-
- 21 undertakings fund created in section [304A-2167,]
- 22 304A-2167.5 to be applied to the payment of the

1		principal of and interest on, and to generate required
2		coverage, if any, for, revenue bonds issued by the
3		board of regents of the University of Hawaii to
4		finance the cost of construction of a university
5		health and wellness center, including a new medical
6		school facility, to be situated on the island of Oahu,
7		for the succeeding fiscal year; and the payment of
8		annual operating expenses incurred by the new medical
9		school facility; provided that any moneys in excess of
10		the amounts required under this paragraph shall be
11		transferred in the succeeding fiscal year [in the
12		following amounts:

14		under section 328L-3[-eighty per cent of the
15		excess; and
16		(B) To the Hawaii tobacco prevention and control
17		trust fund under section 328L 5 twenty per cent
18		of the excess.]; and
19	(5)	Twenty-five per cent shall be deposited to the credit
20		of the state general fund."
21	SECT	ION 3. Section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
22	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

1	"(a) There is established in the state treasury the
2	emergency and budget reserve fund which shall be a special fund
3	administered by the director of finance, into which shall be
4	deposited:
5	(1) [Twenty four and one half per cent of the moneys]
6	Moneys received from the tobacco settlement moneys
7	under section $\left[\frac{328L-2(b)(1);}{2}\right]$ 328L-2; and
8	(2) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund."
9	SECTION 4. Section 328L-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"[$\{\cdot\}$ §328L-4[$\{\cdot\}$] Use of funds appropriated to the
12	department. The department, immediately upon receipt of the
13	[thirty five per cent of] moneys appropriated pursuant to
14	section 328L-2(b)(2) shall:
15	(1) Transfer up to ten per cent of the total moneys
16	received by the State from tobacco settlement moneys
17	to the department of human services for the children's
18	health insurance program; and
19	(2) Expend the remainder of the moneys received by the
20	department for health promotion and disease prevention
21	programs, including but not limited to, maternal child
22	health and child development programs, promotion of

1	healthy lifestyles (including fitness, nutrition, and		
2	tobacco control), and prevention oriented public		
3	health programs.		
4	For purposes of paragraph (2), the director shall convene		
5	an advisory group that shall be separate from the tobacco		
6	prevention and control advisory board, to strategically plan the		
7	development and implementation of preventive systems to achieve		
8	measurable outcomes and to make recommendations for the		
9	expenditure of these moneys. The advisory group shall be		
10	composed of nine members with expertise in the programs under		
11	paragraph (2), and shall be selected at the discretion of the		
12	director."		
13	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
15	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009, and		
16	be repealed on June 30, 2011; provided that section 328L-2,		
17	Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which		
18	it read on the day before the effective date of Act 264, Session		
19	Laws of Hawaii 2007.
