A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State is 1 undergoing a significant and possibly protracted economic 2 downturn in tandem with the national and global economic and 3 4 financial crises. Numerous jobs have been lost, a number of large and small companies have declared bankruptcy or left the 5 State, and many families have suffered foreclosure on their 6 over-mortgaged houses. In the past year, the council on 7 revenues has consistently reduced its forecasts of Hawaii's tax 8 revenues. Across-the-board spending restrictions have already 9 10 been put in place in state government and a general hiring 11 freeze has already been implemented except in areas that impact public health and safety. 12

In the face of these extraordinary conditions, the State cannot proceed with business as usual. All resources must be examined to address critical statewide health, safety, and educational needs.
