A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCLUDED EMPLOYEES.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to require 2 each state appropriate authority to establish a furlough program 3 for the authority's state excluded employees. SECTION 2. Definitions. For the purpose of this Act: 4 5 "Appropriate authority" means the same as defined under section 89C-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. "Excluded employee" means the same as defined under section 7 8 89C-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 9 "State appropriate authority" means: 10 (1) An appropriate authority of the state government; (2) The president of the senate and speaker of the house 11 12 of representatives for state excluded employees of the senate and house of representatives, respectively; and 13 (3) The executive director of the state ethics commission. 14 15 "State excluded employee" means an excluded employee of the 16 state government. SECTION 3. Furlough program; establishment. Except as 17
 - provided under section 4, each state appropriate authority shall

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- 1 establish a furlough program for state excluded employees under
- 2 the authority's jurisdiction. Under the program, each state
- 3 excluded employee shall be furloughed without pay for one day
- 4 per calendar month during the fiscal biennium 2009-2011.
- 5 SECTION 4. Exemption from furlough program. (a) A state
- 6 appropriate authority may exempt a state excluded employee from
- 7 the furlough program if the authority deems that the exemption
- 8 is necessary to:
- 9 (1) Prevent the reduction of student instructional days of
- 10 the department of education or University of Hawaii;
- 11 or
- 12 (2) Protect public health and safety.
- 13 (b) The president of the senate and speaker of the house
- 14 of representatives, acting jointly, may exempt state excluded
- 15 employees of the senate and house of representatives from any
- 16 furlough requirement for the duration of the regular sessions of
- 17 2010 and 2011, but not any interim before or after the sessions.
- 18 If the president and speaker authorize such an exemption, the
- 19 president and speaker shall furlough the exempt employees
- 20 without pay for four additional days during the interim.
- 21 If the president and speaker authorize exemptions for the
- 22 duration of the regular sessions of 2010 and 2011, the director



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- 1 of the legislative reference bureau shall likewise impose the
- 2 same exemption and furlough requirements on the director's state
- 3 excluded employees.
- 4 SECTION 5. No compensation increase under chapter 89C.
- 5 For the duration of the furlough program, no state appropriate
- 6 authority shall increase the compensation of a state excluded
- 7 employee whose compensation is subject to chapter 89C, Hawaii
- 8 Revised Statutes.
- 9 SECTION 6. Report. Each state appropriate authority shall
- 10 prepare a report before July 1, 2009, of its plan to establish a
- 11 furlough program.
- 12 SECTION 7. Superiority of Act. If any provision of this
- 13 Act conflicts with any other state law, ordinance, executive
- 14 order, or rule, the provisions of this Act shall prevail.
- 15 SECTION 8. Section 89C-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "§89C-6 Chapter takes precedence, when. Adjustments made
- 18 in accordance with this chapter shall take precedence over all
- 19 contrary local ordinances, executive orders, legislation, or
- 20 rules adopted by the State or a county, or any department,
- 21 agency, board, or commission thereof, including the personnel
- 22 departments or the merit appeals boards [-]; provided that, for



- 1 the duration of the furlough program established under Act
- 2 Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, section 5 of the Act shall apply."
- 3 SECTION 9. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 6 provided that the amendment to section 89C-6, Hawaii Revised
- 7 Statutes, shall be repealed on June 30, 2011, and section 89C-6,
- 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes shall be reenacted in the form in which

9 it existed on the day before the effective date of this Act.
