A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the sunset

 date on the prohibition on approving benefit enhancements while

 an unfunded accrued liability exists.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 88-122, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 6 "(e) Commencing with fiscal year 2005-2006 and each
- 7 subsequent fiscal year, the employer contributions for normal
- 8 cost and accrued liability for each of the two groups of
- 9 employees in subsection (a) shall be based on fifteen and three-
- 10 fourths per cent of the member's compensation for police
- 11 officers, firefighters, and corrections officers and thirteen
- 12 and three-fourths per cent of the member's compensation for all
- 13 other employees. Commencing with fiscal year 2008-2009 and each
- 14 subsequent fiscal year, the employer contributions for normal
- 15 cost and accrued liability for each of the two groups of
- 16 employees in subsection (a) shall be based on nineteen and
- 17 seven-tenths per cent of the member's compensation for police
- 18 officers, firefighters, and corrections officers and fifteen per HB LRB 09-1086.doc



- 1 cent of the member's compensation for all other employees. The
- 2 contribution rates shall amortize the total unfunded accrued
- 3 liability of the entire plan over a period not to exceed thirty
- 4 years.
- 5 Effective January 2, 2008 [until January 2, 2011], there
- 6 shall be no benefit enhancements under this chapter for any
- 7 group of members, including any reduction of retirement age,
- 8 when there is an unfunded accrued liability.
- 9 The contribution rates shall be subject to adjustment:
- 10 (1) If the actual period required to amortize the unfunded
- 11 accrued liability exceeds thirty years;
- 12 (2) If there is no unfunded accrued liability; or
- 13 (3) Based on the actuarial investigation conducted in
- accordance with section 88-105."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
