A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL MEALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to modify the method 2 by which the prices of school meals, which include both lunch 3 and breakfast, are determined. With the yearly increases in 4 food, fuel, and labor costs, the department of education must be 5 able to adjust the prices of school meals so that the cost to 6 students is no less than half of the cost of preparing the meals. Currently, the method for determining school lunch 7 8 prices is provided by statute, while school breakfast prices are 9 set by administrative rule. School breakfast and lunch prices 10 should be set using the same method.

SECTION 2. Section 302A-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows:

14 "<u>"School meals</u>" means breakfasts and lunches that are 15 prepared and served by a school cafeteria and provided to 16 students."

17 SECTION 3. Section 302A-405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 18 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: HB HMS 2009-1131 HB HMS 2009-1131

1	"(a) The price for [the] school [lunch] <u>meals</u> shall be set
2	by the department to ensure that moneys received from the sale
3	of the [lunches may] <u>meals shall</u> be [up to] <u>no less than</u> one-
4	half of the cost of preparing the [school lunch.] <u>meals.</u> The
5	[price] prices for [the] school [lunch_shall] <u>meals may</u> be
6	adjusted annually based on the [average cost of preparing the

11	SECTION 4. Section 302A-1146, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

13	"§302A-1146 Schools; merchandise. It shall be unlawful
14	for any public school, without the written permission of the
15	department, to operate stores or to sell merchandise, with the
16	following exceptions: school [lunches,] <u>meals,</u> milk, ice cream,
17	candy, and products made or grown at the school as part of the
18	educational program. The department, with the advice of the
19	comptroller, shall adopt rules in conformance with chapter 91

20 necessary for the purposes of this section."

21 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
