## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 287-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Whenever a driver's license has been suspended or 4 revoked: 5 [(1) Pursuant to section 291E-65 or part III of chapter 291E, except as provided in section 291E-41(f);  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  (1) Upon a conviction of any offense pursuant to law; 8 or 9  $[\frac{(3)}{2}]$  (2) In the case of minors, pursuant to part V of 10 chapter 571, 11 the license shall not at any time thereafter be issued to the person whose license has been suspended or revoked, nor shall 12 13 the person thereafter operate a motor vehicle, unless and until 14 the person has furnished and thereafter maintains proof of 15 financial responsibility; provided that this section shall not 16 apply to [a license suspended pursuant to section 291E 61(b)(1) 17 or (b)(2) or section 291E-64(b)(1), any conviction [of] for a 18 moving violation, any administrative license suspension pursuant HB LRB 09-1787.doc

- 1 to chapter 291A, or the first conviction within a five-year
- 2 period for driving without a valid motor vehicle insurance
- 3 policy.
- 4 This subsection shall not apply to a suspension or
- 5 revocation of a license under chapter 291E or a provisional
- 6 license under section 286-102.6(d)."

- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
