BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 103D-323, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Unless the policy board determines otherwise by 4 rules, bid security shall be required only for construction contracts to be awarded pursuant to sections 103D-302 and 5 6 103D-303 and when the price of the contract is estimated by the 7 procurement officer to exceed [\$25,000] the limits of section 8 103D-305, or, if the contract is for goods or services, the 9 purchasing agency secures the approval of the chief procurement 10 officer. Bid security shall be a bond provided by a surety 11 company authorized to do business in the [State,] state, or the 12 equivalent in cash, or otherwise supplied in a form specified in 13 rules." Section 103D-324, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 SECTION 2. 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Unless the policy board determines otherwise by
 rules, the following bonds or security shall be delivered to the
 purchasing agency and shall become binding on the parties upon

- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009 and
- 4 shall be repealed on July 1, 2012; provided that sections 103D-
