1 "Whole" means the entire shark with its head and flesh 2 intact, allowing for the removal of the blood, internal organs, 3 and tail at sea." 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 5 6 begun, before its effective date. 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title: Fishing; Sharks; Finning

Description:

Prohibits importation to the state or possession of shark fins unless the fins were taken from a shark landed whole in the state. Prohibits the sale of shark fins. Applies prohibition to all vessels stopping to refuel or offload cargo or otherwise in transit through waters of the State. Establishes presumption regarding possession of shark fins not attached to the carcass. (HB1775 HD1)
