A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§264- Highway improvements; indemnity of private
5	developer and nonliability of state and county for provision
6	<pre>prior to warrant. (a) A private developer that constructs any</pre>
7	improvements to any state or county highway:
8	(1) At the request of a state or county agency;
9	(2) In accordance with specifications approved by the
10	state or county agency; and
11	(3) Prior to the improvements being warranted pursuant to
12	a traffic impact analysis report, approved or accepted
13	by the state or county agency,
14	shall be indemnified by the State, if the agency requesting the
15	improvements was a state agency, or by the appropriate county,
16	if the agency requesting the improvements was a county agency,
17	from any liability to any person for any injury, including
18	wrongful death, arising from, out of, or resulting from,
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2	improvements prior to their being warranted.
3	(b) If the State or any county accepts and opens to public
4	use any improvements on any state or county highway and the
5	improvements were not determined to be warranted by a traffic
6	impact analysis report that was accepted by the State or
7	appropriate county, then neither the State nor the appropriate
8	county extends any assurances that the unwarranted improvements
9	are safe for any purpose and shall not be held liable to any
10	person for any injury, including wrongful death, or damage to
11	person or property, arising from, out of, or resulting from,
12	directly or indirectly, the unwarranted improvements to the
13	state or county highway."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
