A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KUPUNA HONORARY DEGREE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 "§10-Kupuna honorary degree program. (a) The office 5 of Hawaiian affairs may develop and administer the kupuna 6 honorary degree program, which shall award the pohaku degree, 7 intended to be Hawaii's equivalent to the Nobel Prize, to 8 eliqible Hawaiian kupuna. 9 The pohaku degree shall be awarded in the following 10 categories according to minimum age requirements to be 11 determined by the kupuna komike created in subsection (c): 12 (1) Religion; **13** (2) Health; (3) 14 Agriculture; 15 (4)Fishing; **16** Crafts and weaving; (5) **17** (6) Celestial navigation; 18 (7) Education;
