A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COASTAL AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 205A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending the definition of "shoreline" to read as follows:

4 ""Shoreline" means the upper reaches of the wash of the waves, other than storm and seismic waves, at high tide during 5 the season of the year in which the highest wash of the waves 6 7 occurs, usually evidenced by the edge of natural vegetation 8 growth, or the upper limit of debris left by the wash of the 9 waves [-], whichever is further most mauka, but never lower than 10 the upper limit of debris left by the wash of the waves." 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
