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#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CEDED LANDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is in the 2 interest of the State and all the people of Hawaii to resolve native Hawaiian claims to ceded lands, and until such time the 3 legislature also finds the sale or exchange of ceded lands to be 4 a breach of the fiduciary responsibility of the State as a 5 6 steward of those lands under article XII, section 4, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii. 7 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the sale or exchange 8 9 of ceded lands by the State. SECTION 2. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 10 11 by adding two new sections to be appropriately designated and to 12 read as follows: 13 "§171-A Sale of lands in the public land trust. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no sale in fee simple 14 15 shall be made of: 16 (1) Lands ceded to the United States by the Republic of 17 Hawaii under the joint resolution of annexation,

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1 (2) Grant easement by direct negotiation or otherwise for
2 particular purposes in perpetuity on [such] terms as
3 may be set by the board, subject to reverter to the
4 State upon termination or abandonment of the specific
5 purpose for which it was granted, provided the sale
6 price of [such] the easement shall be determined
7 pursuant to section 171-17(b).

8 No person shall be eligible to purchase or lease public lands, 9 or to be granted a license, permit, or easement covering public 10 lands, who has had during the five years preceding the date of 11 disposition a previous sale, lease, license, permit, or easement 12 covering public lands cancelled for failure to satisfy the terms 13 and conditions thereof."

SECTION 4. In codifying the new sections added by section of this Act, the revisor of statues shall substitute appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating the new sections in this Act.

18 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2013.
