A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The thirteenth representative district
- 2 encompasses the area of East Maui, including Paia, Kuau, Haiku,
- 3 Honopou, Kailua, Huelo, Keanae, Wailua, Hana, Kipahulu, and
- 4 Kaupo and the islands of Lanai, Kahoolawe, Molokini, and
- 5 Molokai, including Kalaupapa. This is the only and last "canoe"
- 6 district or disconnected legislative district. Thus, each
- 7 island area has vastly different capital improvement project
- 8 needs.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for capital
- 10 improvement projects for the thirteenth representative district.
- 11 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
- 12 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
- 13 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
- 14 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:
- 15 1. To be expended by the department of education:
- 16 A. Lanai high and elementary school, Lanai
- 17 Construction for a new classroom building.
