A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 302A-1504, 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the department of education to 3 establish a school-level minor repair and maintenance account that does not exceed \$25,000 per school for use by each public 4 5 school, and requires the department of education to make annual 6 reports to the director of finance on the total amount of funds 7 in the account that shall carry over to the next fiscal year. 8 The legislature also finds that the account and reporting 9 requirements apply to the school-level minor repairs and 10 maintenance special fund established by section 302A-1504.5, 11 Hawaii Revised Statutes. The special fund receives funds from 12 the income check-off on state income tax refunds pursuant to 13 section 235-102.5(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes. The legislature 14 finds that the amount of moneys normally deposited into the 15 special fund is such that a school-by-school accounting of 16 moneys in the special fund is unnecessary. The legislature 17 further finds that section 37-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, sets 18 forth reporting requirements for all non-general funds, HB1852 HD1 HMS 2010-1413

including the school-level minor repairs and maintenance special
fund. For these reasons, the legislature finds that the
requirements of section 302A-1504, Hawaii Revised Statutes, are
duplicative and unnecessary.

5 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the school-level minor 6 repair and maintenance account and reporting requirements.

7 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1504.5 is amended to read as 8 follows:

9 "§302A-1504.5 School-level minor repairs and maintenance 10 special fund. There is established within the state treasury a 11 special fund to be known as the school-level minor repairs and 12 maintenance special fund, into which shall be deposited all 13 moneys collected pursuant to section 235-102.5(b), and any other 14 moneys received by the department in the form of grants and 15 donations for school-level minor repairs and maintenance. The 16 special fund shall be administered by the department and used to 17 fund school-level minor repairs and maintenance.

The department shall submit:

19 (1) A report to the director of finance, no later than
20 ninety days after the close of each fiscal year, which
21 shall be prepared in a form prescribed by the director
22 of finance and which shall identify the total amount
