BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) There is established a joint legislative

4	(b)	The task force shall consist of ten members as

6	(1)	Two members of the house of representatives appointed
7		by the speaker of the house of representatives with

9	(2)	Two members of the senate appointed by the president
10		of the senate with one member serving as co-chair of
11		the task force;
12	(3)	Four members representing organizations providing
13		services to victims of domestic violence, two of whom
14		shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of
15		representatives and two of whom shall be appointed by
16		the president of the senate; and
17	(4)	Two members who are domestic violence victim

1	speaker of the house of representatives and one of
2	whom shall be appointed by the president of the
3	senate.

- 4 (c) Members of the task force shall serve without5 compensation and shall receive no reimbursement for expenses.
- 6 (d) All proceedings and records of the task force shall be7 exempt from chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 8 (e) The task force shall submit a report of its findings
 9 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
 10 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
 11 the regular session of 2011.
- 12 (f) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2012.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
