A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD LABELING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§328-A Illness caused by fish or fish products
5	misbranding; penalties. (a) Any person whose misbranding of
6	fish or fish products in violation of section 328-6 results in
7	the illness of a consumer of the product shall be fined a
8	minimum of \$1,000 for a first offense, a minimum of \$2,500 for a
9	second offense, and a minimum of \$3,500 for a third offense.
10	Any fines collected under this section shall be deposited into
11	the food misbranding special fund established by section 328-B.
12	(b) The penalties under this section are in addition to
13	any other penalties provided by law.
14	§328-B Food misbranding special fund. There is
15	established the food misbranding special fund to be administered
16	by the department and into which shall be deposited:
17	(1) Legislative appropriations to the special fund;

1 (2) All moneys received by the department from fines 2 imposed under section 328-A; 3 (3) All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in the special fund shall become part of the special 4 5 fund; and 6 (4) Any other moneys made available to the fund. 7 Moneys in the special fund shall be expended to cover all costs 8 associated with carrying out the purpose of section 328-A." SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 10 11 begun before its effective date. 12 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section 13 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 14 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating the new sections in this Act. 15 16 SECTION 4.
