A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD LABELING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Illness caused by fish or fish products "§328-A 5 misbranding; administrative penalties. (a) The director may 6 impose administrative fines upon any person whose misbranding of 7 fish or fish products in violation of section 328-6 results in 8 the illness of a consumer of the product; provided that the 9 illness has been certified by a physician licensed under chapter 10 453. The fine for a violation under this section shall be a 11 minimum of: 12 (1) \$ for a first violation; 13 (2) \$ for a second violation; and 14 for a third violation. (3) \$ 15 Any fines collected under this section shall be deposited into 16 the food misbranding special fund established by section 328-B. 17 (b) The penalties under this section are in addition to

any other penalties provided by law.

- 1 Food misbranding special fund. (a) There is §328-B 2 established the food misbranding special fund to be administered 3 by the department and into which shall be deposited: 4 (1) Legislative appropriations to the special fund; 5 (2) All moneys received by the department from fines 6 imposed under section 328-A; 7 (3) All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in 8 the special fund; and 9 Any other moneys made available to the fund. (4)**10** (b) Moneys in the special fund shall be expended to cover 11 all costs associated with carrying out the purpose of section 12 328-A." 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 15 begun before its effective date. 16 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section **17** 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 18 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
