# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CLUBS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 486N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§486N- Military personnel; federal active duty
5	deployment outside State; cancellation or suspension of
6	contract. (a) In addition to cancellation of a health club
7	contract under sections 486N-6 and 486N-7, a health club
8	contract of a member of the United States military, including a
9	member of the Hawaii National Guard, United States military
10	reserves, or regular United States armed forces who is serving
11	on federal active duty or active duty in federal service and
12	deployed or otherwise serving outside of this State during the
13	term of the contract, may be canceled or suspended provided that
14	the request for cancellation or suspension:
15	(1) Is made by the member or the member's legally

designated representative;

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1	(2)	Includes a copy of the member's official military	
2		orders, a written verification from the member's	
3		commanding officer, or other proof of deployment; and	
4	(3)	Is made within ninety days after the member receives	
5,		notice of serving on federal active duty or active	
6		duty in federal service, for deployment or service	
7,		outside of this State.	
8	(b)	If a contract is suspended under this section, the	
9	health cl	ub shall not charge any fees to reinstate the contract	
10	and shall	maintain in the reinstated contract the original	
11	payment obligations set forth in the original contract.		
12	(c)	A contract that is suspended pursuant to subsection	
13	(a) shall	be subject to cancellation two years from the date of	
14	suspensio	n if the health club member fails to reinstate the	
15	contract.		
16	(d)	If cancellation or suspension is made pursuant to	
17	subsection	n (a), the health club shall immediately refund to the	
18	member, t	he entire consideration the member paid for the health	
19	club cont	ract, less an amount computed by dividing the total	
20	contract	price by the number of weeks in the term of the	
21	contract	and multiplying the result by the number of weeks	
22	elapsed a	t the time of cancellation or suspension."

### Report Title:

Health Clubs; Cancel or Suspend Membership; Deployed Military

#### Description:

Allows military personnel deployed outside the State on federal active duty to cancel or suspend health club membership at any time during the contract term under certain conditions.
