9	<u>(a)</u>	Commits a violent crime in or on the real property

14	<u>(c)</u>	Commits a violent crime while on any school vehicle,
15		or within ten feet of a parked school vehicle during
16		the time that the vehicle is in service for or waiting
17		to transport school children.

1	(2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a		
2	<u>class A felony.</u>		
3	(3) For the purposes of this section:

7	"School vehicle" means every school vehicle as defined in
