BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "S6E- Repatriation. The repatriation of human remains,
- 5 funerary objects, sacred objects, or objects of cultural
- 6 patrimony subject to the Native American Graves Protection and
- 7 Repatriation Act of 1990, Pub.L. 101-601, 104 Stat. 3048-3058,
- 8 25 U.S.C. 3001-3013, shall be accomplished in consultation with
- 9 the appropriate island burial council, Hui Malama, the office of
- 10 Hawaiian affairs, the designated native Hawaiian organization,
- 11 and lineal or cultural descendants."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
