## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this bill is to repeal the
- 2 temporary two per cent increase in the transient accommodations
- 3 tax scheduled to be implemented between July 1, 2010, and June
- 4 30, 2015.
- 5 SECTION 2. Act 61, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended
- 6 by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 7 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009,
- 8 and shall be repealed on [June 30, 2015;] July 1, 2010; provided
- 9 that sections 237D-2 and 237D-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 10 shall be reenacted in the form in which they read on June 30,
- **11** 2009."
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
