A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW THE GOVERNOR TO APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION UPON CONFIRMATION BY BOTH THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2	amendment to article X, sections 2 and 3, of the Hawaii
3	Constitution to allow the governor to appoint the members of the
4	board of education and the superintendent of education upon the
5	advice and consent of both the state house of representatives
6	and the senate.
7	SECTION 2. Article 10, section 2, of the Hawaii
8	Constitution is amended to read as follows:

8	shall select a public high school student to serve as a

10	The board of education shall have the power, as provided by

12	There shall be a superintendent of education, as the chief
13	executive officer of the public school system, who shall be
14	nominated and, by and with the advice and consent of both the
15	house of representatives and senate, appointed by the governor.
16	Members of the board of education and the superintendent of
17	education shall hold office for a term to expire at the end of
18	the term for which the governor was elected, unless sooner
19	removed by the governor.
20	If the manner of removal of a member of the board of
21	education or the superintendent of education is not prescribed
22	in this constitution, removal shall be as provided by law.

1	When the legislature is not in session and a vacancy
2	occurs, appointment to which requires the confirmation of both
3	the house of representatives and the senate, the governor may
4	fill the office by granting a commission which shall expire,
5	unless such appointment is confirmed, at the end of the next
6	session of the legislature. The person so appointed shall not
7	be eligible for another interim appointment to such office if
8	the appointment failed to be confirmed by both the house of
9	representatives and the senate.
10	No person who has been nominated for appointment to any
11	office and whose appointment has not received the consent of
12	both the house of representatives and senate shall be eligible
13	to an interim appointment thereafter to such office."
14	SECTION 3. Article 10, section 3, of the Constitution of
15	the State of Hawaii is repealed.
16	[" POWER OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
17	Section 3. The-board of education shall have the power, as
18	provided by law, to formulate statewide educational policy and
19	appoint-the superintendent-of-education as the chief executive
20	officer of the public school system."]
21	SECTION 4. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
22	be as follows:



"Shall the members of the Board of Education and the
 Superintendent of Education be appointed by the Governor
 upon the advice and consent of both the House of
 Representatives and the Senate of the State of Hawaii?"
 SECTION 5. Constitutional material to be repealed is
 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
 underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This amendment shall take effect upon
9 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Hawaii
10 Constitution.
