### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§183D- Prohibited acts. Notwithstanding any law to		
5	the contrary, it shall be unlawful to:		
6	(1) Possess or use a snare to hunt or take wildlife;		
7	(2) Use bait to hunt or take wildlife; or		
8	(3) Take wildlife for the purpose of keeping the wildlife		
9	as a pet."		
10	SECTION 2. Section 183D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
11	amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately		
12	inserted and to read as follows:		
13	""Bait" means the laying of food in a hunting area, whether		
14	or not used in conjunction with any device, to attract game,		
15	game birds, game mammals, predators, wild birds, wildlife, or		
16	wild mammals.

10	(1)	For a first conviction by a mandatory fine of not less	
11		than \$200, or by imprisonment of not more than one	
12		year, or both;	
13	(2)	For a second conviction within five years of a	
14		previous conviction, by a mandatory fine of not less	
15		than \$1,000, or by imprisonment of not more than one	
16		year, or both, and all firearms <u>or snares</u> used in the	
17		commission of such violations shall be considered	
18		contraband to be forfeited to and disposed of by the

20	(3)	For a third or subsequent conviction within five years	
21		of the first two or more convictions, by a mandatory

not more than one year, or both, and all firearms or

 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
