A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2010. 3 SECTION 2. Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is 4 amended by amending part II to read as follows: 5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS 6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may 7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of 8 9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium 10 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The total 11 expenditures and the number of permanent positions established 12 in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the 13 sums and the position ceilings indicated for each year, except 14 as provided in this Act.

If any portion of a specific appropriation is 17 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall 18 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the 19 20 extent possible.
