### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 291-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§291-57 Parking spaces reserved for persons with	
4	disabilit	ies; penalties. (a) Any [ <del>person who</del> ] <u>driver or</u>
5	registere	d owner of a vehicle that uses a parking space reserved
6	for perso	ns with disabilities who:
7	(1)	Fails to properly display a removable windshield
8		placard, a temporary removable windshield placard, or
9		special license plates;
10	(2)	Displays an invalid removable windshield placard, an
11		invalid temporary removable windshield placard, or
12		invalid special license plates;
13	(3)	Uses a removable windshield placard, a temporary
14		removable windshield placard, or special license plate
15		that was not issued to that person or to any
16		passengers occupying the vehicle in the parking space;

1	(4) With or without a removable windshield placard, a
2	temporary removable windshield placard, or special
3	license plates:
4	(A) Parks in an access aisle; or
5	(B) Obstructs the ingress or egress to a parking
6	space reserved for a person with a disability;
7	shall be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and
8	shall be fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$500 and pay any
9	costs incurred by the court related to assessing the fine;
10	provided that a person with a disability who has been issued a
11	valid placard or special license plate that is currently in
12	effect, and who has failed to display the placard or license
13	plate while parking in a space reserved for persons with
14	disabilities, shall pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more
15	than \$100 and any costs incurred by the court related to
16	assessing the fine.
17	(b) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for
18	persons with disabilities and refuses or fails to present an
19	identification card issued under this chapter or the rules
20	adopted thereunder to an enforcement officer upon request shall
21	be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and shall
22	be fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$500.
