BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 46-15.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding,
4	any county and its authorized personnel may impose and enforce
5	traffic laws and shall enforce chapters <u>249,</u> 286 <u>, 287, 291,</u>

7	streets, roads, or highways whose ownership is in dispute
8	between the State and the county."
9	SECTION 2. Section 46-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:

3 (1)Any private street, highway, or thoroughfare which has been used continuously by the general public for a 4 5 period of not less than six months; provided that the 6 county shall not be responsible for the maintenance 7 and repair of the private street, highway, or 8 thoroughfare when it imposes or enforces traffic 9 regulations and highway safety laws or places or 10 permits to be placed appropriate traffic control 11 devices on that street, highway, or thoroughfare; 12 provided further that no adverse or prescriptive 13 rights shall accrue to the general public when the 14 county imposes or enforces traffic regulations and 15 highway safety laws or places appropriate traffic 16 control devices on that street, highway, or 17 thoroughfare; nor shall county consent to the 18 placement of traffic control signs or markings on a 19 private street be deemed to constitute control over 20 that street; and

Expands county enforcement of traffic regulations on public streets, roads, or highways whose ownership is in dispute between the State and the county, and on private streets, highways, or thoroughfares, to include laws relating to county vehicular taxes, motor vehicle safety responsibility, traffic violations, use of intoxicants while operating a vehicle, motor vehicle insurance, motorcycle and motor scooter insurance, and odometers.
