#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 128-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"\$128-19 Immunity from liability of private shelter. If individual, partnership, firm, society, unincorporated association, joint venture group, hui, joint stock company,
