A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIRTH DEFECTS WARNING SIGNS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need for
 public information about the risk of birth defects, specifically
 fetal alcohol syndrome, when women consume alcoholic beverages
 during pregnancy. The United States Surgeon General has
 recommended that women abstain from alcohol during pregnancy.
 The legislature believes that alcohol related birth defects are
 preventable if people are aware of the risks.

8 The purpose of this Act is to require establishments that 9 serve alcoholic beverages to post a warning sign to inform 10 customers of the dangers of alcohol consumption during 11 pregnancy.

12 SECTION 2. Section 281-44, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended to read as follows:

14 "§281-44 Advertisements and signs upon licensed premises.
15 (a) All licensed premises shall post a sign in or about the
