A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the University of Hawaii's 2 Shidler College of Business' Doctoral Program in International 3 Management is important to the State's economy because it encourages foreign-born graduates from Asian countries, many of 4 5 which have growing economies and investment opportunities, to 6 invest in Hawaii businesses. The recent downturn in the 7 economy, however, has resulted in funding cuts that threaten the 8 participation of the three doctoral candidates in the program. 9 The legislature also finds that ensuring the program's 10 viability will help the Shidler College of Business maintain its

11 current U.S. News and World Report top twenty-five ranking and 12 that this endeavor is in the public's interest, as it will 13 benefit the State's economy and the University of Hawaii system. 14 The purpose of this measure is to provide funds to maintain the 15 University of Hawaii Shidler College of Business' Doctoral 16 Program in International Management viability by providing 17 assistance to the program's doctoral candidates.
