A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the assessment of SECTION 1. fees for parking on roadways and in parking areas under the 2 3 jurisdiction of the department of education can serve as a 4 revenue source to benefit public education. Authorizing the 5 department of education to assess fees for parking in areas and 6 facilities under its jurisdiction will provide the department 7 with another source of revenue to address the massive budget 8 reductions and restrictions affecting public education. 9 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of 10 education to adopt rules and assess fees for parking on roadways 11 and in parking areas under its jurisdiction. 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 14 designated and to read as follows: 15 **Parking; control by department.** (a) The "§302A-16 department may adopt rules in accordance with chapter 91 to 17 govern the traffic and parking conditions on roadways and other areas under the jurisdiction of the department. 18
