## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CERTIFICATION OF PRINCIPALS AND VICE-PRINCIPALS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of

2 education currently has requirements for the certification of

3 its principals and vice-principals. The legislature also finds

4 that the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

5 provides educational funds for states that pursue educational

6 reform and additional funds for those states that qualify for

7 Race to the Top funds by advancing educational reform. One of

8 selection criteria for Race to the Top funds is providing

9 alternative routes to certification for teachers and principals;

10 however, section 302A-605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, currently

11 provides for one pathway to certification and exceptions on a

12 case-by-case basis.

13 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of

14 education to establish alternative routes to certification for

15 principals and vice-principals. The alternative requirements

16 shall meet the federal government's Race to the Top fund

17 selection criteria.

- SECTION 2. Section 302A-605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

  "\$302A-605 Principals and vice-principals. (a)

  Principals shall meet the department's certification
- 5 requirements and shall have not less than five years of
- 6 appropriate school-level experience of which at least three
- 7 years shall have been as a teacher.
- 8 (b) Vice-principals shall meet the department's
- 9 certification requirements and shall have appropriate school-
- 10 level experience as determined by the department.
- 11 [(c) On a case by case basis, the department may waive the
- 12 certification requirements and school level experience for vice
- 13 principal candidates with-appropriate-administrative experience.
- 14 The department shall establish criteria and reasons for waivers
- 15 pursuant to chapter 91.]
- (c) The department shall determine additional alternative
- 17 routes to certification for both principals and vice-principals.
- 18 The department shall establish alternative routes to
- 19 certification pursuant to chapter 91.
- 20 (d) For purposes of this section, "alternative routes to
- 21 certification" has the same meaning as the term "alternative
- 22 routes to certification" determined by United States Department



- 1 of Education regulations for state applications for Race to the
- 2 Top fund allocations under section 14001 of the federal American
- 3 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, as amended."
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

### Report Title:

School Principals and Vice-Principals; Alternative Routes to Certification
