BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "§286-102.6 Provisional license for persons under the age 4 of eighteen. [Section repealed on January 9, 2011. L 2005, c 5 72, \$15] (a) A person may be granted a provisional license to 6 drive passenger cars of any gross vehicle weight rating, buses 7 designed to transport fifteen or fewer occupants, and trucks and 8 vans having a gross vehicle weight rating of fifteen thousand 9 pounds or less if the person: 10 Is at least sixteen years of age but under the age of 11 eighteen; 12 (2)Holds an instruction permit and has held the permit 13 for a period of at least one hundred eighty days and 14 there is no pending proceeding that might result in 15 the suspension or revocation of the instruction 16 permit; [and]
