A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 180C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
 and to read as follows:

 Change in use of land; conservation plan void.
- 5 (a) A conservation plan that is approved by the applicable soil
- 6 and water conservation district shall be void if there is a
- 7 subsequent change in the use of the land that is not consistent
- 8 with the use approved in the conservation plan. The plan shall
- 9 be deemed void as of the date of the change in the use of the
- 10 land.
- 11 (b) Any exemptions from ordinances that were obtained
- 12 based upon a conservation plan that is void pursuant to
- 13 subsection (a) shall be void as of the date of the change in the
- 14 use of the land, or the effective date of this Act, whichever
- occurs later, and the land use shall be subject to any
- ordinances enacted pursuant to section 180C-2."
- 17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.



SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
