SECTION 1. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"§132D-17 [Inconsistent-county ordinances, rules.] County 3 4 authority. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [no 5 county shall] counties may enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or articles pyrotechnic [, except as 6 required in this chapter,] that [is inconsistent with or] are 7 more restrictive than [-7] the provisions of this chapter. 8 Any 9 ordinances and rules regulating fireworks or articles 10 pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except those provisions [which] that are not 11 12 [inconsistent] consistent with  $[\tau]$  or more restrictive than those of this chapter, are declared void." 13 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010, and 16

17 shall be repealed on June 30, 2012; provided that on July 1,
