A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
 amendment to article X, section 1, of the Constitution of the
 State of Hawaii to require the public school system to provide a
 minimum of one hundred ninety instructional days in a school
 year.

6 SECTION 2. Article X, section 1, of the Constitution of7 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:

8 "Section 1. The State shall provide for the establishment, 9 support and control of a statewide system of public schools free 10 from sectarian control, a state university, public libraries and 11 such other educational institutions as may be deemed desirable, 12 including physical facilities therefor. The statewide public 13 school system shall provide for a minimum of one hundred ninety 14 instructional days in each school year. There shall be no 15 discrimination in public educational institutions because of 16 race, religion, sex or ancestry; nor shall public funds be 17 appropriated for the support or benefit of any sectarian or

1 nonsectarian private educational institution, except that 2 proceeds of special purpose revenue bonds authorized or issued 3 under section 12 of Article VII may be appropriated to finance 4 or assist:

5 1. Not-for-profit corporations that provide early
6 childhood education and care facilities serving the general
7 public; and

8 2. Not-for-profit private nonsectarian and sectarian
9 elementary schools, secondary schools, colleges and
10 universities."

SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

13 "Shall the state constitution be amended to require that the 14 public school system provide a minimum of one hundred ninety 15 instructional days per school year?"

16 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is 17 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is 18 underscored.
