A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 328L-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§328L-4 Use of funds appropriated to the department. The
4 department, immediately upon receipt of the moneys appropriated

pursuant to section 328L-2(b)(2) shall:

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- (1) Transfer up to ten per cent of the total moneys received by the State from tobacco settlement moneys to the department of human services for the children's health insurance program; and
- (2) Expend the remainder of the moneys received by the department for health promotion and disease prevention programs, including but not limited to, maternal child health and child development programs, promotion of healthy lifestyles (including fitness, nutrition, and tobacco control), and prevention oriented public health programs.

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[For purposes of paragraph (2), the director shall convene
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    an advisory group that shall be separate from the tobacco
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    prevention and control advisory board, to strategically plan the
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    development and implementation of preventive systems to achieve
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    measurable outcomes and to make recommendations for the
    expenditure of these moneys. The advisory group shall be
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    composed of nine members with expertise in the programs under
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    paragraph (2), and shall be selected at the discretion of the
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    director. 1"
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         SECTION 2. Section 328L-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended to read as follows:
         "§328L-5 Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund.
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    (a) There is established the Hawaii tobacco prevention and
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    control trust fund as a separate fund of a nonprofit entity
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    having a board of directors and qualifying under section
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    501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, into
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    which shall be deposited moneys received as provided under
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    section 328L-2(b)(3). The director of health with the
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    concurrence of the governor, shall select, in accordance with
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    law, the entity based upon the proven record of accomplishment
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    of the entity in administering a similar trust fund.
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1	(b) Notwithstanding that the Hawaii tobacco prevention and		
2	control trust fund is established within a private entity, the		
3	department of budget and finance shall have oversight authority		
4	over the fund and may make periodic financial audits of the		
5	fund; provided that the director of finance may contract with a		
6	certified public accountancy firm for this purpose. The		
7	director of health with the concurrence of the governor in their		
8	sole discretion may rescind the selection of the entity. If the		
9	selection of the entity [is] rescinded, moneys in the trust fund		
10	shall revert back to the State and shall be deemed to be trust		
11	moneys.		
12	(c) The entity selected under subsection (a), for each		
13	fiscal year, may expend, as specified by the tobacco prevention		
14	and control advisory board pursuant to section 328L-6, up to		
15	fifty per cent of the total market value of the Hawaii tobacco		
16	prevention and control trust fund on the preceding June 30, for		
17	tobacco prevention and control, including but not limited to,		
18	reducing cigarette smoking and tobacco use among youth and		
19	adults through education and enforcement activities, and		
20	controlling and preventing chronic diseases where tobacco is a		
21	risk factor. The entity selected under subsection (a) may make		
22	recommendations to the tobacco prevention and control advisory

- 3 (d) The Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund
- 4 may receive appropriations, contributions, grants, endowments,
- 5 or gifts in cash or otherwise from any source, including the

- 8 that any appropriations made by the State shall not supplant or
- 9 diminish the funding of existing tobacco prevention and control

- 13 control trust fund shall consist of:
- 14 (1) Moneys appropriated under section 328L-2(b)(3);
- 15 (2) Moneys appropriated to the Hawaii tobacco prevention
- and control trust fund by the state, county, or
- 17 federal government;
- 18 (3) Private contributions of cash or property; and
- 19 (4) Income and capital gains earned by the trust fund.
- 20 (f) The aggregate principal sum deposited in the Hawaii
- 21 tobacco prevention and control trust fund shall be invested by
- 22 the entity selected under subsection (a) in a manner intended to

Section 328L-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended to read as follows: 9 "[+]\$328L-6[+] Tobacco prevention and control advisory 10 board. (a) There is established a tobacco prevention and 11 control advisory board under the department for administrative 12 purposes. 13 The tobacco prevention and control advisory board 14 shall consist of members who are involved in tobacco prevention 15 and control. Membership of the board shall be as follows: 16 [(1) One member of the governor's staff, appointed by the 17 governor; 18 (1) One member to be appointed by the governor from a 19 list of two names submitted by the president of the 20 senate;

9	SECTION 4. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is
10	amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
11	"SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009,
12	and shall be repealed on June 30, 2015; provided that [section]
13	sections 328L-2, 328L-3, and 328L-4 shall be reenacted in the
14	form in which [it] they read on the day before the effective
15	date of Act 264, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007[-]; provided
16	further that the amendments made to section 328L-4, Hawaii
17	Revised Statutes, by section 1 of Act , Session Laws of
18	Hawaii 2010, shall not be repealed when that section is
19	reenacted on June 30, 2015."
20	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
