## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PREPAID CALLING SERVICE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 487, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	"§487- Prepaid calling service; definitions;	
5	disclosures; rules; violation. (a) Any prepaid calling service	
6	company that sells or offers for sale prepaid calling service,	
7	at the ti	me of sale, shall disclose clearly and conspicuously:
8	(1)	Any surcharges or fees, including monthly fees, per
9		call access fees and surcharges for the first minute
10		or unit of use that may be applicable to the use of
11		the prepaid calling service;
12	(2)	Any rounding of time used by the user and the formula
13		of computation of the rounding of time;
14	(3)	Any application or other fees charged to the user;
15	(4)	Any restrictions on use of the prepaid calling
16		service; and
17	(5)	A toll-free user assistance telephone number.

1	(b) The director of the office of consumer protection may		
2	adopt rules under chapter 91 prescribing additional information		
3	that a prepaid calling card company shall provide to the user a		
4	the time of sale.		
5	(c) A violation of this section shall be deemed an unfair		
6	or deceptive act or practice under section 480-2.		
7	(d) As used in this section:		
8	"Prepaid calling service" means a prepaid		
9	telecommunications service that allows a user to originate a		
10	telephone call using an access number and an authorization code		
11	"Prepaid calling service company" means a company that		
12	provides a prepaid calling service to the public using its own		
13	network or resold services.		
14	"Telecommunications service" means the provision of		
15	transmission service between or among points specified by a		
16	user, of information of the user's choosing, including voice,		
17	data, image, graphics, and video without change in the form or		
18	content of the information, as sent and received, by means of		
19	electromagnetic transmission, or other similarly capable means		
20	of transmission, with or without benefit of any closed		
21	transmission medium, and does not include cable service as		
22	defined in section 440G-3."
