A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Under section 89-9(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, negotiations between the exclusive representative and the 2 employer are permitted on the amounts that the State and the 3 4 counties contribute under sections 87A-32 through 87A-37, Hawaii 5 Revised Statutes, toward the payment of health benefit plan 6 The parties are not permitted to use the binding costs. 7 arbitration process to resolve disputes relating to the employer contributions to the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust 8 9 fund under part IV, chapter 87A, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 10 Because the parties were unable to resolve their differences 11 through negotiations, it was agreed through a letter of understanding that this issue would be submitted to the 12 13 legislature for resolution. The parties also agreed to abide by 14 the legislature's decision.
