A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. On September 21, 2009, the legislature held 2 informational briefings to gather information to determine the 3 broad range impacts of potential layoffs within the department 4 of business, economic development, and tourism office of 5 planning, particularly those in the coastal zone management 6 program and land use division. Seven positions within the 7 office of planning were scheduled to be eliminated, including 8 the manager of the coastal zone management program and three of 9 five positions in the land use division. 10 The informational briefings focused on a number of priority 11 concerns, including the loss of federal funds for mandated 12 coastal zone management program functions, adverse impacts on statutorily-mandated programs, and inadequacies of state 13 14 representation in land use proceedings as imminent and critical.

The purpose of this Act is to ensure greater stability and

- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 225M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 5 and to read as follows:
- 6 "§225M- Planning special fund. (a) There is
- 7 established in the state treasury the planning special fund,
- 8 into which shall be deposited:
- 9 (1) Appropriations by the legislature;
- 10 (2) Federal funds granted by Congress or executive order;
- 11 and
- 12 (2) Donations and contributions made by private
- individuals or organizations for deposit into the
- fund.
- 15 (b) Moneys in the fund shall be used for the operations of
- 16 the office of planning, including personnel costs of staff
- 17 positions existing on November 1, 2009; provided that the use of
- 18 moneys from the fund for current and future personnel costs
- 19 shall be limited to those employees performing specialized
- 20 duties necessary to meet the statutory and federal mandates of
- 21 programs within the office of planning."
- 22 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
