4	conservation districts; rules. (a) No person shall install a
5	buoy or mooring or use an illegally installed buoy or mooring in
6	a marine life conservation district.

7 [(a)] (b) The department shall, pursuant to chapter 91,
8 adopt rules for the regulation of anchoring and mooring in each
9 marine life conservation district established under this
10 chapter.

II [-(b)-] (c) Within its jurisdiction over ocean recreational boating and coastal activities, the department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 for the regulation of boating in each marine life conservation district established under this chapter."
