- 4 fingerprint-based criminal history record information through
- 5 the Hawaii criminal justice data center on individuals
- 6 identified in subsection (b) for the first [two-years] year that
- 7 an individual identified in subsection (b) is required to [have
- 8 such] undergo criminal history record checks, and shall conduct
- 9 a name-based criminal history record [name] inquiry into the
- 10 state criminal history records annually or biennially
- 11 thereafter."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
