BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

15	SECTION 2. Section 88E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

1 "§88E−5 [Appointment] Election and terms. Except for the 2 directors of human resources development and finance, the 3 members of the board shall [be nominated and, by and with the 4 advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the governor and 5 shall] serve terms of four years each; provided that of the 6 trustees first [appointed_upon_establishment of] elected to the 7 board one shall be [appointed] elected for a term of one year, 8 one shall be [appointed] elected for a term of two years, one 9 shall be [appointed] elected for a term of three years, and two 10 shall be [appointed] elected for a term of four years. 11 A vacancy on the board shall be filled by appointment [of 12 the governor.] for an unexpired term of a trustee by the 13 remaining trustees. The person appointed to fill a vacancy 14 shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. If by the 15 end of a term a trustee is not [reappointed] reelected or a 16 successor [is not appointed,] has not been elected, the trustee 17 shall serve until the trustee's successor is [appointed.] duly 18 sworn into office. 19 Membership on the board shall not be deemed incompatible 20 with the holding of any other public employment." SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 21 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
