4	Except as provided in section 707-701, a person commits the

9	(b)	Acting either alone or with one or more persons,	
10		commits or attempts to commit any of the following	
11		crimes and, in the course of and in furtherance of the	
12		crime that the person is committing or attempting to	
13		commit or during the immediate flight therefrom, the	
14		person, or another participant if there be any, causes	
15		the death of a person other than one of the	
16		participants:	

(i) Kidnapping, as defined in section 707-720; 17

[-(2)] (3) Murder in the second degree is a felony for 1 which the defendant shall be sentenced to imprisonment as 2 provided in section 706-656." 3 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 5 6 begun, before its effective date. SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 9
