A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEASUREMENT STANDARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
- 2 weights and measurements special fund, with the intent of
- 3 requiring the department of agriculture's measurement standards
- 4 program to be financially self-supporting.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by adding to part I a new section to be appropriately
- 7 designated and to read as follows:
- 8 "§486- Weights and measurements special fund. There is
- 9 established the weights and measurements special fund to be
- 10 administered by the board. All moneys received by the board as
- 11 application fees and for licenses or otherwise under this
- 12 chapter shall be deposited into the special fund. All interest
- 13 earned or accrued on moneys deposited in the special fund shall
- 14 become part of the special fund. Moneys in the special fund
- 15 shall be expended to cover all costs of administering this
- 16 chapter, including but not limited to the costs of salaries,
- 17 fringe benefits, operating expenses, equipment, motor vehicles,
- 18 contracts for services, and promotional expenses. Moneys in the

- 1 special fund may be transferred to the general fund for salaries
- 2 and fringe benefits of other state employees assisting in
- 3 administering this chapter and other related costs. A reserve
- 4 shall be maintained in the special fund to cover contingency
- 5 costs, including accrued vacation leave, unemployment insurance,
- 6 and workers' compensation."
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) Between July 1, 2010 and September 30,
- 8 2010, the board of agriculture shall adopt new or amend existing
- 9 rules to impose or increase fees authorized to be charged under
- 10 chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, without regard to the
- 11 public notice and public hearing requirements of section 91-3,
- 12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, or the small business impact review
- 13 requirements of chapter 201M, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
- 14 board shall set the fees at amounts intended to generate
- 15 sufficient revenues to pay the operation and maintenance costs
- 16 of implementing chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and
- 17 central services and departmental administrative expense
- 18 assessments of section 36-27 and section 36-30, Hawaii Revised
- 19 Statutes.
- 20 (b) If, by September 30, 2010, the board of agriculture
- 21 has not complied with subsection (a), then the fee charged for
- 22 each licensing, testing, calibration, or inspection of a

- 3 (c) Any subsequent amendments to the rules adopted or
- 4 amended pursuant to subsection (a) or the fee established under
